Membership is open to all youth grades K-12. The 4-H enrollment age is determined by the member's grade as of January 1.

Each 4-H member selects at least one project. Youth have the opportunity to choose an area that they have experience in, or are interested in learning about. Check with your Extension Office or 4-H Club to get all the details!
